Anyone may designate which of the Darke County United Way Agencies will receive their donation by writing the agency of their choice under Donor Special Instructions. No administrative fee is taken from these contributions. Outside DCUW Agencies possessing a 501(c)(3) and that are a health and human service agency may also be designated to but require a minimum donation of \$25.00 and will be subject to an administrative handling fee. The fee charged is based on actual expenses utilizing a 3-year average from the Darke County United Way IRS Form 990 to establish management, general, and fundraising expenses. Leadership gifts of \$1,000 or higher are exempt from this handling fee. Every attempt to honor these designations will be made or the gift will revert back to the Darke County United Way. Any Darke County non profit that has been in business for one year, serves health and human services, and possesses a 501(c)(3) may apply for 2010 funding through Darke County United Way.
