Coordinator Instructions

- 1. Publicize! Publicize!** Let employees/customers know about this great project for Darke County school children! Be creative! Use posters the United Way provides or you can design your own. Remind employees through the internet. Hang reminder posters in the bathrooms stalls. If you need more poster supplies, please contact the United Way staff at 547-1272.
- 2. Set a deadline!** The actual collection/event date is Friday, August 6 from 9:00 AM – 4:00 PM at the following location: JC Penney parking lot (Greenville) or Versailles Dollar General parking lot. You can run the collection until that day but at least until the day before.
- 3. Designate a collection point!** Decide where a good collection point would be for the employees and if you are a collection point for the community. Have good-sized boxes, barrels or crates available for the supplies. Keep checking to make sure that your collection container is not overflowing and always has room for more!
- 4. Recruit a volunteer** - who will bring the supplies to the Drive-In on August 6.
- 5. Call the United Way Staff!** if you have any questions, need any assistance.
- 6. Feel great about what you have done!** Because of your efforts, energy and time, hundreds of Darke County children will have the opportunity to go to school with the tools needed to learn and no worries about going without!
